Overview

The San Antonio Regional Education Forum was first staged in 2016 to connect educators with civic, business, and nonprofit leaders to address Bexar County's most pressing PK-12 public education challenges and opportunities. Widespread pessimism about the state of San Antonio's inner city public schools and education outcomes had resulted in a general lack of civic engagement on the part of many in the leadership community. The forum is a deliberate effort by its founders to push back against false assumptions and stereotypes, and win greater engagement across the community to improve public education outcomes.

A range of education issues and topics have been addressed, including public school finance in Texas; early childhood education; the role of the church community in Pre-K schooling; public schools district and public charter school competition and collaboration; nontraditional school partnerships; school board governance; and the immeasurable value teachers have on students lives.
